



ASSOCIATION WITH THE EUROPEAN SOCIETY OF HYPERTENSION

This Agreement dated: December 16th, 2011

BETWEEN

The European Society of Hypertension, Swiss Association with ID: CH-170.6.000.149-S, whose registered offices are at c/o lic.lut, Untermüll 6, CH-6302 Zug, and which is VAT-exempt, represented by Prof. Josep Redon, in his capacity as President,

herein referred to as the “ESH”,

AND

The Sociedad Argentina de Hipertensión, Argentinian Association with registered office at Tte. Gral. Juan Domingo Perón 1479 2do. "4" - C1037ACA – Buenos Aires, Argentina, represented by Dr. Daniel Piskorz in his capacity as President,

herein referred to as the “AS”

This agreement outlines the terms and conditions for the development of an ASSOCIATION PROGRAMME between the AS and the ESH. The AS and the ESH are hereafter referred to as the “Parties”

Association Programme Development

Association is an official recognition between the Parties by which the AS expresses their intention to be part of and to participate in the regular activities of the ESH. The purpose is to promote the interests of science through defined and formal cooperation in the field of hypertension and cardiovascular protection.

- This Association agreement means that the AS is: a) Officially recognized as part of the ESH; b) Shares the purposes and aims of the ESH; c) Will have access to the resources, network, and training programmes of the ESH; d) Will facilitate working relationships in pursuit of the ESH goals; e) Will encourage, stimulate and provide

perspectives in research and the clinical care of hypertension and hypertension-related vascular risk.

- The associated societies will receive the following benefits: a) Annual Meetings of the AS which fulfil the criteria of the ESH, even national activities, may receive the endorsement of the ESH; b) The AS can use the ESH logo in their documents (Associated with the ESH); c) Representatives of the AS can actively participate in the Annual Meeting of the ESH; d) Master Courses for teaching and training can be developed.
- The associated societies undertake to promote the activities of the ESH and encourage their members to take an active role by participating to the best of their ability in furthering the goals of the ESH
- The AS will follow the approved rules for submission to become associated with the ESH.
- The Association agreement can be terminated unilaterally by the AS or the ESH Scientific Council.
